

Mausoleum Contract Awarded

Gillard/Milne Construction Australia has won the tender to build the \$6.5 million Fremantle Mausoleum complex, due to be completed around July 2005.

The mausoleum will be the fourth in Western Australia, contributing 996 crypts for families choosing above-ground entombment.

It has been designed in classical proportions reminiscent of mausoleums constructed thousands of years ago, with ancient dome and pyramid architectural forms.

Gillard/Milne is a consortium of local firm Gillard Builders and Milne Constructions, an international specialist in mausoleum design and construction.

The Project Manager is Reuben Kooperman of APP (WA) Pty Ltd and the Architect is DesignInc.

The construction of Fremantle Mausoleum follows closely behind three other mausoleum projects currently



underway: Karrakatta Mausoleum Stage 3; Swan Region Mausoleum at Guildford Cemetery; and Midland Mausoleum at Midland Cemetery.

These three projects will be progressively opened over the next few months.
